


Memorial Held for GSC Student

Durbin earned his Bachelor's Degree in accounting and finance from Glenville State College and his Master's in public administration from West Virginia University. He serves as a Peer Reviewer with the Higher Learning Commission and is a member of the National Association of College and University Business Officers as well as the Southern Association of College and University Business Officers.

Durbin joined the WVU Division of Finance in 2006. While at WVU, he had overall responsibility for central finance functions comprising more than 140 staff members in areas including institutional accounting, budget planning, procurement, payment services, revenue services, risk management, grants accounting, payroll, and financial compliance. Durbin also served as the treasurer for the WVU Research Corporation and the WVU Innovation Corporation. Before joining the finance division, he held financial and administrative leadership positions at the WVU Health Sciences Center for nearly 20 years, ultimately becoming its director of budget and financial operations.
