Minutes
September 15, 2016

- I. President Ratliff called the meeting to order at 12:30 pm.
- II. Roll call was taken by Secretary Carr
- III. Swearing in of new members
 - a. None
- IV. Review of last week's minutes:
 - a. Ali made the motion to accept the minutes with minor corrections
 - i. Nicole seconded the motion
 - ii. All in favor, motion passed.
- V. Congressional Forum
 - a. No one spoke at this time
- VI. Advisor/Administrative Liaison Updates
 - a. Advisor Bailey stated there was a good turnout to today's meeting
 - b. Administrative Liaison Spears introduced himself to the group and explained his role as Acting Dean of Students. He encouraged anyone with any issues, questions, or comments to feel free to come see him in either one of his offices on campus. His office locations are in AB and in the Office of Student Life. His office hours in Student Life are Monday and Thursday from 11:00am – 2:00pm.
- VII. Presidents Report:
 - a. President Ratliff has not attended any meetings and therefore did not have a report at this time
- VIII. Executive Updates
 - a. Vice President Moore stated that the Curriculum Committee will be meeting next Tuesday at 12:30
 - b. Secretary Carr spoke about the non-traditional student lounge, the lounge located in LBH and spoke of the High Adventure program. She encouraged everyone to take part in the upcoming event which is scuba diving in the Lilly pool. She also stated there is an issue at the fountain with cigarette butts and there is need for some type of container for proper disposal. Administrative Liaison Spears made additional comments on the High Adventure program and also encouraged everyone to get involved
- IX. Public Comment:
 - a. Brittany White spoke on the use of the non-traditional lounge. She stated it was being used by people other than the students it was designed for. Secretary Carr stated she realized this was an issue but is unsure how to resolve the problem since we cannot specifically exclude anyone from using the area. Administrative Liaison Spears suggested using signage to increase awareness that it is an area for the non-traditional student.
