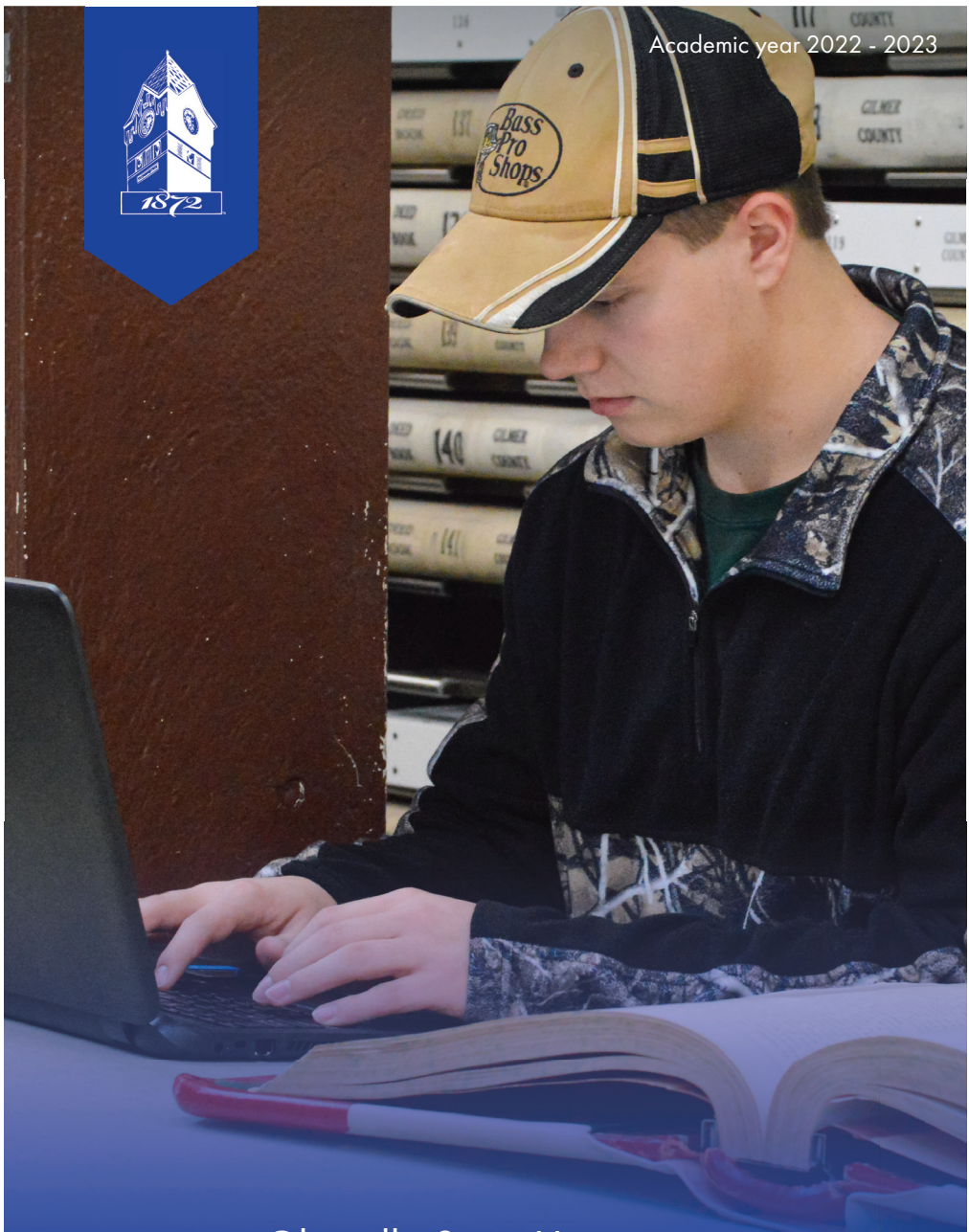

## **ABOUT THE MAJOR**

The Department of Land Resources prides itself on a 'hands-on' approach to learning. Students are provided a teaching and learning experience that duplicates real world applications as closely as possible.

The baccalaureate degree in Natural Resource Management is developed around the general education baccalaureate degree component, a Natural Resource Management core, a specific major, and a block elective component. Energy and Land Management is one of the six 4-year Bachelor of Science majors offered under the Natural Resource Management program.

The Energy and Land Management major is designed for students who are interested in working in land use development, management and planning. Graduates of this program are able to find a large number of career opportunities with federal government agencies, such as U. S. Department of Transportation and the Bureau of Land Management. At the state level, graduates qualify for opportunities with the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Highways and others. Additionally, graduates qualify for private industry positions including, but not limited to, title abstractor, right-of-way agent, realty specialist and oil and gas landman.
