Nursing interventions are established nursing practices with predictable outcomes. Works under the supervision of a higher level medical professional. May provide direction to unlicensed and licensed personnel such as LPN's, aides, and orderlies. Shift work may be required. Travel may be required.

Qualifications: Your application will not be accepted if you do not meet stated minimum requirements.

Training:

Successful completion of an associate degree or higher in nursing from a regionally accredited college or university or a diploma nursing program. (You do NOT have to provide verification at time of application. You will be required to provide verification documents if called for an interview.)

Special Requirement:

Current West Virginia license or temporary permit to practice as a registered professional nurse.

NOTICE: If you are claiming post-high school education, license or special training, you **MUST** attach or provide by mail a legible copy of your education transcript, license or training record. You will not be considered for employment until this verification has been received. To avoid delays in processing your application, it is important that you provide this verification as soon as possible.
