Degrees with two required concentrations should require a minimum of 15 hours in each concentration and limit the total hours in both concentrations to 60 hours. Degree programs should normally include a minimum of 12 hours of general electives outside the primary field of study. A minor outside the degree field may replace general electives. Minors should range between 15 and 21 credit hours. Certificate programs should range from 9-12 credit hours.
