





Montrose and Williams Award Winners



Steven Blake 2009 Frank Montrose Award Winner

Montrose Award

The prestigious Frank Montrose Award has been given annually since 1952 to GSC's top male athlete who graduated during the previous academic year. Selection criteria requires that the graduate be a good athlete, a scholar, a leader, and a person of high moral character. This award is named for Frank Montrose who came to Glenville in the fall of 1939 from Richwood High School (Richwood, WV) where he had established himself as a grid great. Shortly before final examinations in the spring of his freshman year, Frank went blind. A month later, in June 1940, the 21 year old Montrose died in a Baltimore hospital, a victim of nephritis.

Steven Blake was the 2009 Montrose Award winner. He lettered all four years as a member of the Pioneer track team. Steven competed in the shot put, discus, javelin, and hammer throw during his college career. He qualified for the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Championship meet all four years and, in his senior year, was captain of his Pioneer Track team. Additionally he was a member of the Pioneer Football team for two years.



Candace White-Young 2009 Clarissa Williams Award Winner

Williams Award

The Williams Award was established in 1983 and is named for Miss Clarissa Williams, an Associate Professor of Physical Education at Glenville State College who began her career at the college in 1947 and served as the cheerleader sponsor until her retirement in 1964.

Candace White-Young was the 2009 Williams Award winner. She was a four-year starter at catcher and a three-year captain for the GSC softball team. Candace was awarded ALL Conference honors during her sophomore and junior years. She hit two walk-off homeruns to beat Seton Hill and Alderson-Broaddus during the 2009 season and was a key component in the Lady Pioneer's runner-up finish in the WVIAC Tournament. Candace was also an outstanding student, receiving the WVIAC BB& T Student Athlete of the Year Award with a GPA of 3.89.
