Best wishes and the most pleasant of memories to all those associated with Glenville State during 1959-60. Our greatest ambition is for you to enjoy happiness and success.

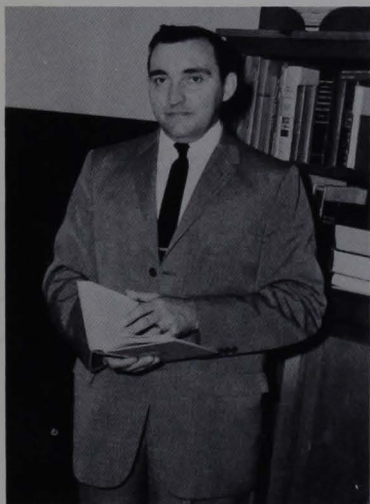

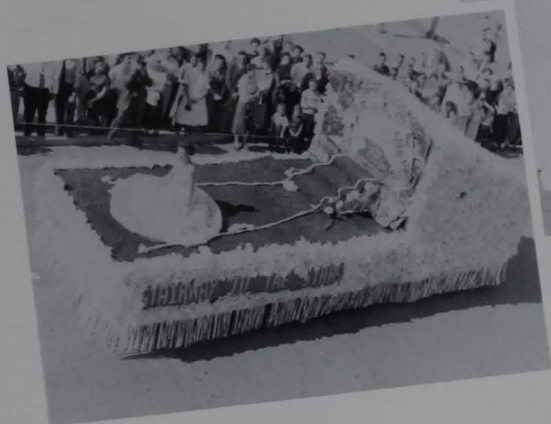

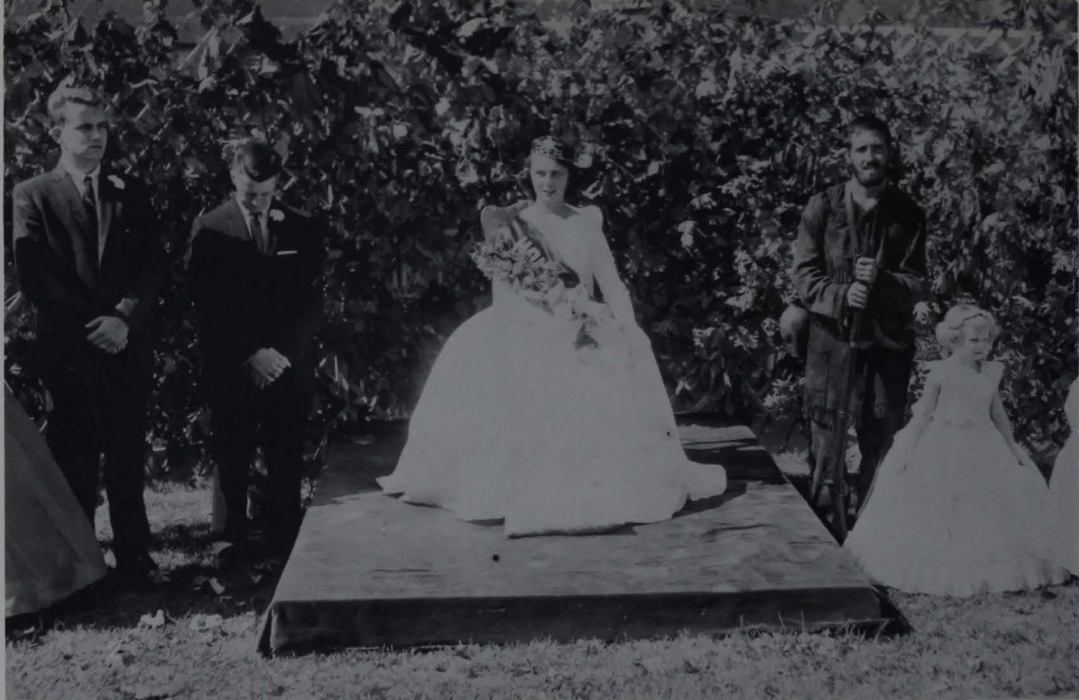


Xi Beta Tau float, "Stairway to the Stars", featured sorority president Phyllis Veith, and tied for first place honors in the parade.
