





"Ye Olde College Farm"

Dr. Max Ward, Chairman, Division of Science and Mathematics, works above and beyond his usual duties of professor of botany at Glenville State College and applies his energies to a unique type of research. The research, in basic botany, aims to uncover things about plants not currently known. At the present time, the work centers around the capacities and activities of the single cell, in ferns and mosses, where these cells may be readily had for study and experimentation. These plants also offer cells and tissues readily adaptable to cultivation in controlled and measurable culture conditions--in glass dishes or tubes, sealed against contamination, yet providing growth conditions which stimulate, as far as possible, many of those in the natural habitat.

Currently, the chief work centers around single, isolated cells of moss callus--or cells which grow and divide continuously but refuse to form organized tissues natural to normal plants. These 'mis-behaving' cells, under current experiments, may be made to organize themselves into tissues and indeed plants of a form not encountered in nature. This control of development results from application of certain growth-controlling chemicals which appear widely in various concentrations in the plant world.

In October and November, 1964, the eighth and ninth articles dealing with these studies were published--one in the British weekly science journal, NATURE, and one in the American journal, THE BRYOLOGIST. At intervals reports on the studies are also presented before meetings of the state and national botanical organizations.

On occasion, a limited number of students in biology take an active part in carrying out certain phases of the experimentation and preparing and presenting the reports. For the past two years Sue Ellen Frederick, a junior in the College, has been closely associated with the research program. She expects to enter graduate school to continue research in botany immediately after graduation.

Professional Distinction

Hundreds of sealed glass test tubes and certain other glass dishes are used for the growth of the plant tissues under controlled conditions. Extreme care, sterile techniques and much time are required to maintain the cultures (view is in special room designed to provide controlled lighting and constant temperature.)





The cultures are inspected regularly--especially the new ones--for any sign of variations in development. Michael Conley here points out a recent development on media containing anti-cancer chemicals.

Other experimentation, especially directed toward students in physiology, deals (as shown here) with the effect of growth retardants and growth accelerators on various plants.
