The Department of Language and Literature at Glenville State College offers a number of programs including a Bachelor of Arts in English, as well as the Bachelor of Arts in Education in English Education and in Spanish Education. Additionally, students may choose to minor in Communication Arts, Information and Media Studies, and Spanish.

In keeping with the GSC's commitment to both literacy and general education, the department offers a number of required courses aimed at introducing students to their literary and cultural heritage while further refining their reading, writing, and speaking skills. Courses required in various degree programs include American Mosaic (critical writing about literature emphasizing ethnic and gender issues) and courses surveying English, American, and World Literature. Upper-level courses in novel, poetry, drama, film, and linguistics, Spanish literature and culture, journalism, and related media are open to students regardless of major. Most important, students have a faculty adviser who will work closely with them and guide them through their respective programs of study.

In addition to meeting the specialized needs of the majors, department courses deepen the student's insight into the human condition and can help ensure success in a variety of fields – from psychology to marketing, from music to pre-law, from chemistry to history.

The recently added Spanish Education program, along with the minor in Spanish, allows students to gain a global perspective of the Spanish language and acquire a deeper understanding of the history and the culture of the people.
