

SWIMMING LESSONS

at the Glenville State College Pool

Health & Physical Education Building – Main Campus

Glenville State College offers a variety of swimming lesson options, from group sessions to private lessons for children or adults. Lessons last a half-hour and are designed to increase knowledge of swim basics, in addition to simply becoming more comfortable in water.

Participants are placed in different Levels, depending upon the swimmer and his or her existing skill set.

Students tend to lose interest and energy if lessons run longer than 30 minutes. We recommend practicing skills during other pool visits for maximum learning experience.

> Breaks are scheduled between lessons for brief discussion. At the end of each Session, you will be given a checklist showing what the student learned and what skills need to be mastered before moving to the next Level.

> > All Group Lessons review safety in and around water.

INFORMATION

Group Swimming Lessons \$45 for Six 30-minute lessons

Group lessons are three to six students of the same age with approximately the same ability. You will be called if there isn't enough enrollment to start the class. You will not be called if the class is running. Please mark your calendar for the date(s) and time(s) enrolled for.

Private and Semi-Private lessons are flexible and are scheduled between the Client and the Swimming Instructor. Daytime and evening hours are available.

Private Swimming Lessons \$65 for Five 30-minute lessons

Private lessons are available for children and adults. One-on-one instruction.

Semi-Private Lessons (for two people) \$85 for Five 30-minute lessons

Semi-private lessons are for siblings or two people close to the same ability.

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GROUP LESSON LEVELS: Level One: Introduction to Basic Water Skills

<u>Prerequisite</u>: Must be comfortable in water. <u>Skills taught</u>: Floating, begin front crawl arms, and flutter kick on front and back. Age 35:30-6:00 p.m. Age 4-66:05-6:35 p.m. Age 7-14.....6:40-7:10 p.m.

Level Two: Aquatic Fundamentals

<u>Prerequisites</u>: Must be able to maintain front and back float for 6 seconds. <u>Skills taught</u>: Combine glide, flutter kick, and alternating arms for both front and back crawl, introduce side stroke.

Age 4-6......6:05-6:35 p.m. Age 7-15.....5:30-6:00 p.m.

Level Three: Stroke Development

<u>Prerequisites</u>: Ability to perform front crawl and move through water. Rotary breathing is not required. <u>Skills taught</u>: Rotary breathing, enhancement of front and back crawl, and side stroke. Introduce butterfly kick. Jumping into deep water and treading.

To view lessons, please sit in the stands above the pool. Parents are not permitted on the pool deck during lessons.

Please enter the pool through the locker rooms, allowing time to use the restroom, dress to swim, and rinse in the showers before taking stairs to the pool area.

Goggles are optional for Level 1, needed for Levels 2 and 3.

Arm floats or swim vests are not needed.

If the student doesn't swim at the same level as those in the Group Lesson, you will be asked to switch him or her to another Level.

It is not uncommon to have to repeat a Level several times before advancing to the next Level.

For Group Lessons that have only one student enrolled, you may be offered a shifted time, a refund, or three Private Lessons.

Make-up Lesson(s) are held during the buffer week between Sessions if a Group Lesson is canceled. They are not available for individuals who miss lessons.
