Biographical Note: Guy Bayard Young

Guy Bayard Young was a graduate of the Glenville State Normal School in 1932. On May 6th, 1935, Young was appointed as a teacher at Gilmer County High School, starting his job on the 9th of September that year. Upon retirement he was recognized for his faithful services as an educator and chemist.

Historical Note: Gilmer County Education, 1885-1987

This historical collection of materials from the 1885 to 1987 period offers a personal glimpse into the lives of many people from the Glenville area. Many of the documents and

photographs are about events at Glenville State Normal School and Gilmer County Public Schools. These artifacts were created at a time when education was changing, even in Gilmer County; the Glenville State Normal School transitioned to a Teachers College and, later, changed to the four-year “Glenville State College.” The public schools were also arranging and changing in order to best accommodate the students. All artifacts documented in this collection represent the lives of Gilmer County people at the time of all these historical changes regarding the education system of central West Virginia.
