Your 2020–2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, a comparison of your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet will be done along with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to our office. Additional information may be requested. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

Important Note: If you filed, or will file, an amended 2018 Federal income tax return, you cannot use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. You must request a Return Transcript and an Account Transcript at www.IRS.gov, or call 1-800-908-9946. If you have been a victim of identity theft, please contact our office for instructions.

Read Instructions: Complete this section if you filed or will file a 2018 income tax return with the IRS. The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of the FAFSA on the Web. If you have not already used the tool, go to FAFSA.gov, log into your FAFSA record, select “Make FAFSA Corrections,” and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form.
