Kappa Omicron – the campus chapter of the national education honorary, Kappa Delta Pi – sponsors the Glenville State College Outstanding Intern Award each semester. The award goes to one intern who exemplifies the high ideals expected of teaching professionals. In addition, the award winner will be nominated for the National Intern Award sponsored by Kappa Delta Pi.

Kappa Delta Pi is now accepting nominations for this prestigious award. Interns who fit the following eligibility criteria may be nominated.

- Have an overall grade-point average of 3.0 or higher
- Be committed to teaching as a full-time career
- Be nominated by his or her partner teacher or supervising teacher

In order to complete the nomination process the following guidelines must be met:

- All responses must reflect the applicant's best writing skills, be typed and double-spaced, and conform to word limitations noted
- Each applicant must provide:
 - A completed application (attached)
 - A lesson plan
 - One videotape that includes an introduction, a lesson, and a reflection

All nominations, whether partner teacher or supervising teacher initiated, must be received by the Advisor for Kappa Delta Pi prior to or on Friday, April 17, 2020. All nominations will be reviewed by a committee of Kappa Delta Pi members. The award will be presented on Exit Day, the final day for interns to be on campus.
