ACADEMIC POLICY 29

PUBLIC SCHOOL SERVICE CREDITS

29.1. General

1.1. Scope – This policy is Glenville State College’s policy in regard to public school service credits.

1.2. Authority - West Virginia Code §18B-2A-5

1.3. Effective Date – April 19, 2006

1.4. Repeal of former rule – This policy supersedes any or all Glenville State College policies in reference to public school service credits.

29.2. Public School Service Credits

2.1. Glenville State College students may earn credit towards graduation for service performed in the public schools as tutors, student advisors, and mentors to instill in public school students the benefits of postsecondary education attainment.

2.2. Students interested in earning such credit should contact the Office of the Dean of Teacher Education. Placements for all public school service shall be coordinated through the Office of the Field Experiences Director in Teacher Education.

2.3. The Dean of Teacher Education shall oversee the public school service of Glenville State College to assure that it meets all academic standards.
