## Minutes

## February 9, 2016

- I. President Ratliff called the meeting to order at 12:30 pm
- II. Roll call was taken by Secretary Carr
- III. Swearing in of new members:
  - a. None
- IV. Review of last week's minutes:
  - a. Senator LeMasters made a motion to accept the minutes as presented
    - Senator Neal second the motion
    - ii. All in favor, the motion passed.
- V. Congressional Forum:
  - a. Senator Boback stated the Wi-Fi in Goodwin Hall is much better.
  - b. Senator Neal stated he has been talking with Dr. Vavrek about some possible academic policy changes. Senator Neal will keep the group updated. Administrative Liaison Walters suggested talking to Dr. Bone in the music department.
- VI. Advisor Updates/Administrative Liaison Updates:
  - a. Advisor Gross stated there will be a "make your own dreamcatcher" event in the Musket at 12:15 pm on Wednesday.
  - b. Administrative Liaison Walters stated tonight was a "paint party" in the Musket at 7 pm and Friday at 7 pm will be "make your own memory boards" in the Musket as well.
- VII. Presidents Report:
  - a. President Ratliff gave an update on the Board of Governors meeting he attended. He brought up the issue of fees attached to taking online classes. He feels \$150.00 for each class is excessive and the Board will look into the issue. The Presidential Candidates will be on campus on February 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, and the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. All students are encouraged to attend the meeting and ask questions of the candidates. He informed the group of a new scholarship program based on alumni referrals. The scholarship will be for \$500.00 per semester and the recipient must stay in the dorms in order to receive the funds.
- VIII. Executive Reports:
  - a. Vice President Moore stated he spoke with Dr. Vavrek about the tassels. He called the bookstore and there might be an issue with all the colors not being available. He will be meeting with him again to see what has been figured out.
  - b. Secretary Carr gave an update to the nontraditional lounge. She stated she spoke with Tom Ratliff about nonstudents using the lounge and he said a possible solution would be to lock the door of the evening. She asked Senator Schreckengost what a good time would be to have the doors locked and she stated

after 4 pm would be good. Secretary Carr will relay that information to Mr. Ratliff.
