January 19, 2016

- I. President Ratliff called the meeting to order at 12:42 pm
- II. Roll call was taken by Secretary Carr
- III. Swearing in of new members:
  - a. None
- IV. Review of last week's minutes:
  - a. Senator LeMasters made a motion to accept the minutes as presented
    - i. Senator M. Carr second the motion
    - ii. All in favor, the motion passed.
- V. Congressional Forum:
  - a. Senator Shreckengost informed the group there have been several students voice concerns to her regarding the shuttle drivers. It was stated Jerry Burkhammer was aware of some of the situations and any further complaints should be directed to him.
  - b. Senator Neal stated Jerry is aware of the issues with some of the drivers but what would be helpful is to note the date and time of the incidents so he may correctly identify the drivers who are working at that time.
  - c. Senator LeMasters stated one of the vending machines in Goodwin Hall lobby is not working. Treasurer Woods will look into the issue.
  - d. Senator Neal stated he agreed with everything that was said regarding the situation that occurred on Tuesday of last week. He also stated there are some student workers that need to shape up. There have been issues with the night crew in the Musket and if you have any specific issues and names, let Lisa in Dining Services know.
- VI. Advisor Updates/Administrative Liaison Updates:
  - a. Advisor Gross stated she purchased board games to be used at 10 East Main. She said they are available there now but you must check them out with the front desk worker.

  - a. President Ratliff stated he attended a facilities committee meeting. Nothing major was discussed and nothing was voted on. Senator Howard asked what will be done with the area where the Fitness Center is located when it is moved to the PE building. Administrative Liaison Spears stated nothing has been decided at this point but if you have ideas, give them to President Ratliff so he may give them to the Facilities Committee for consideration. President Ratliff then stated he attended two meetings of the Presidential Search committee. There have been both good and bad candidates with a total of 47 applying for the position.
