February 23, 2016

- I. President Ratliff called the meeting to order at 12:30 pm
- II. Roll call was taken by Secretary Carr
- III. Swearing in of new members:
 - a. None
- IV. Review of last week's minutes:
 - a. Senator Schreckengost made a motion to accept the minutes as presented
 - i. Senator A. Howard second the motion
 - ii. All in favor, the motion passed.
- V. Congressional Forum:
 - a. Senator Neal reminded the group of the basketball games tonight at the Waco. It is a white-out.
 - b. Senator A. Howard informed the group the pool table at 10 East Main has been out of service for some time now. He asked if it would be repaired anytime soon because there are events being held there such as a pool tournament. Advisor Gross suggested bringing the pool table down from Goodwin Hall if the repair would not happen soon. Administrative Liaison Spears will look into the situation.
