# GLENVILLE STATE COLLEGE FALL 2020 - RETURN TO CAMPUS -

# **BEFORE ARRIVING**

**ALL STUDENTS** (returning and new) will be expected to have a PCR-based COVID-19 test completed with results no more than one week prior to arrival on campus if possible.

### If results are **POSITIVE**:

Students should contact GSC and will be engaged by Academic Success Center staff and faculty members to develop an online delivery schedule while they quarantine at home.

### If results are **NEGATIVE**:

Students should proceed to campus on their scheduled day/time and will be required to take the GSC-administered antigen-based COVID-19 test upon arrival on campus.

### **HOW TO SEND YOUR RESULTS:**

The results of tests taken before arrival on campus should be shared with GSC in one of two ways:

- Faxed or emailed by your healthcare provider to the Office of Admissions at (304) 462-0578 or admissions@glenville.edu

- Brought to campus upon returning

# **UPON ARRIVAL**

All students will be screened for temperature and symptoms and will receive a GSC-administered antigen-based COVID-19 test.

#### If results are **POSITIVE**:

The student will be immediately directed to obtain a PCR-based test and quarantine until results are received. If confirmed positive, they must remain quarantined for 14 days\*.

\*Students are permitted to quarantine at home if preferred.

### If results are **NEGATIVE**:

The student may move into their residence hall.

# THROUGHOUT THE SEMESTER

Beginning August 18 through November 20, 3% of the campus population (students, faculty, and staff) identified by clusters based on department will be tested weekly with a GSC-administered antigen-based COVID-19 test.

- Students, faculty, and staff will be notified in advance of the day, time, and location they must show up to be tested.
- Students not feeling well or experiencing ill symptoms will be screened by the campus nurse and, depending on the screening results, may be sent for testing.
- Any individual who tests positive will need to take a PCR-based COVID-19 test to confirm.
  Upon confirmation they will need to be quarantined.

All students are urged to limit their movement as much as possible, practice social distancing, and wear a mask where required.
