



Dear Glenville State College Pioneers:

Everyone here at GSC is looking forward to welcoming you to campus this fall. We have been planning in partnership with local healthcare professionals in order to safely do just that. However, we must all do our part.

In accordance with our return to campus plan and to ensure you have a seamless transition to our campus for the fall semester, we expect all students to be tested for COVID-19 prior to their arrival at Glenville State.

Our hope is for you to be tested and have results obtained one week prior to returning to campus. All students should get tested on their own in their home communities with a PCR-based COVID-19 test. The results of those tests should be brought to campus upon returning or shared with GSC beforehand (*sent from the healthcare facility performing the test via email to admissions@glenville.edu or by fax to (304) 462-0578*).

We understand that some students may not be able to obtain a COVID-19 test in their area for various reasons or that, even if a test is performed, results may not be returned by the time you come to GSC. If that is the case, know that you are still able to come on campus for orientation or move-in activities.

Immediately upon arrival for orientation or move-in activities, all students will be directed to the Waco Center to be tested with an on-campus, rapid antigen-based COVID-19 test. Commuters and students residing off-campus are all also expected to abide by the testing requirements.

Students will receive information about orientation and/or move-in/check-in activities and dates in a separate email.

To ensure the continued safety of the campus community, testing will continue throughout the fall semester for all students, faculty, and staff.

Your health and safety are of the highest concern for me and my colleagues. We hope this plan may alleviate any concerns that you may have, but we welcome any questions.
