

They also prepared the evidence they collected for presentation to a judge.

In later years, he created some 800+ weekly cartoons for two award-winning hometown newspapers; *The Glenville Democrat* and *The Ritchie Gazette*. He never retired from doing what he loved best. As wished, even his final cartoon appears in his hometown newspaper.

His lifetime of artwork on canvas and in clay features over 4,000 WV paintings including: a series of rural WV landscapes and a series of river boats on the Ohio River. George and his wife of 46 years, Sharon (Low) Harper '70, also enjoyed many summers painting a series of watercolors of the quaint coastal fishing villages along the Atlantic near Peggy's Cove, Maine and the coastline of Nova Scotia. His favorite and final series, which features the beauty of small local country churches, was painted in memory of his beloved mother and simply titled "SPIRITUAL GLOW."
