



Due to a technical issue, last week's Pioneer Update is coming to you a few days late. With all of the recent developments related to COVID-19 in West Virginia and beyond, we also wanted to provide you with an update about the actions we are taking on campus.

On Monday, March 23, West Virginia Governor Jim Justice instituted a "stay-at-home" order effective at 8:00 PM on Tuesday, March 24. Glenville State College will continue delivery of instruction to students and to provide essential services to those students who must remain on campus to complete their academic coursework. As part of the Governor's order, only essential staff will be reporting to work, campus events are being canceled through the end of April, and campus buildings and offices will be closed.
