Dr. Jack H. Albert Jr. '70 is the 16th president of St. John's Northwestern Military Academy in Delafield, Wisconsin. He has more than 30 years' experience leading secondary military schools and has been president of St. John's Northwestern since 2004.

Dr. Albert began his professional life as a public school teacher and discovered his vocation for military school education in 1983, when he began teaching Bible studies parttime at Randolph-Macon Academy in Front Royal, Virginia. During his military school career, Dr. Albert has served as Director of Guidance and Academic Dean at Randolph-Macon

#### Bond Refinance Creates Campus Efficiency

Although it was finalized with little fanfare, we wrapped up a \$39 million bond issuance this week that will help GSC manage expenses, cut costs, and create more opportunities to help students.



The College refinanced several bonds with variable interest rates into one with a lower rate of interest. That allows for financial savings that can be passed along to current students. The move is similar to refinancing a home mortgage, just on a larger scale.

Savings gained from the bond issuance will go to improve several academic, student life, and faculty and staff areas across campus including the campus fitness center, classroom technology, faculty and staff computers, campus and student housing, and various other safety and environmental systems.
