## ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Science and Mathematics offers classic baccalaureate (four-year) degrees in chemistry, biology, science education, and mathematics education. Many students major in biology or chemistry (or both) to prepare for diverse careers ranging from wildlife biology and ecology to preparing for professional schools in fields such as medicine, pharmacy, and dentistry.

GSC's small size facilitates more personalized student-faculty interactions in the classroom and laboratory, with a hands-on, experiential approach to science education. Students conduct research with modern laboratory instrumentation, learn about West Virginia's diverse ecosystems at the Fernow Experimental Forest, local State Parks, and other natural areas in the state including trips to Cranberry Glades and Dolly Sods to compare what these ecosystems have to offer, and study abroad.

Much of the instrumentation the department uses was purchased with NASA grants to enhance the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math fields, allowing undergraduates to complete science research.
