ACTION ITEM: Bundling Fees for all Students at GSC

COMMITTEE: Ad Hoc Tuition and Fees Committee

RECOMMENDED RESOLUTION: Be it RESOLVED that the Board of Governors endorses and approves the College implementing Bundling Fees for all students at Glennville State College.

BACKGROUND:

Presently Glennville State College has over 40 separate student life, activity, and academic related fees that are not part of tuition. This presents challenges for the administration on several fronts including billing, account collections, recruitment, and retention. One example of a challenge this presents is for students who do not know upfront how much they will owe the college.

To address this concern, an Ad Hoc Committee was formed (consisting of Rita Hedrick-Helmick, Ann Reed, Bert Jedamski, Gary Morris, Stephany Harper, Jesse Skiles, Chelsea Stickelman, Tom Ratliff, Jason Yeager) to evaluate and make a recommendation. After multiple meetings, the committee arrived at a model that bundles fees together according to the residency of a student (residential, commuter, and online degree programs). This model has the benefit of allowing a student to know what the full bill will be before the first day of class.

Proposed Bundled Fees Schedule for 2021-2022

Category	Fee	Current fees it includes
Full-time residential	\$500/semester	Academics, parking, cable, refrigerator, IT, student services, and web based course fee.
Full-time commuter	\$380/semester	Academics, parking, IT, student services, and web based course fees
Part-time commuter	\$250/semester	Academics, parking, IT, student services, and web based course fees
Online Degree Programs – Off-campus resident	\$205/semester	Academics, IT, and student services

ACTION ITEM: Tuition Increase for Online Degree Seeking Students at GSC

COMMITTEE: Ad Hoc Tuition and Fees Committee

RECOMMENDED RESOLUTION: Be it RESOLVED that the Board of Governors endorses and approves the College to increase tuition for students in online degree programs at Glennville State College.

BACKGROUND:

Presently Glennville State College charges students enrolled in online degree programs a flat fee of \$200 per semester. The Committee is proposing to build this fee into the tuition for online degree program seekers only, and to have a single tuition rate for all online degree seekers, regardless of being in state or out of state. This resolution will increase tuition for a full-time online degree program student from \$3,943 to \$4,143 irrespective of the student's residency (out of state or instate). The tuition will keep us competitive with other institutions that are fully online.

ACTION ITEM: Increase in Room Rate for Pioneer Village,
Riverfront and Goodwin Hall

COMMITTEE: Ad Hoc Tuition and Fees Committee

RECOMMENDED RESOLUTION: Be it RESOLVED that the Board of Governors endorses and approves the College to change the room rate for Pioneer Village, Riverfront and Goodwin Hall.

BACKGROUND:

This resolves to increase the rate for single-occupancy room upgrades from \$668 to \$700 at Goodwin Hall and Riverfront, and from \$488 to \$500 at Pioneer Village. The new single-occupancy room rates at each location are \$3,591 per semester at Goodwin Hall and Riverfront, and \$3,391 per semester at Pioneer Village.
