

# Independent Student Verification Worksheet 2022-2023

Your 2022–2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, a comparison of your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet will be done along with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You, and spouse, if married, must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to our office. Additional information may be requested. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

# **C. STUDENT TAX RETURN FILERS**

**Important Note:** If you filed, or will file, an <u>amended</u> 2020 Federal income tax return, you cannot use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. You must request a <u>Return Transcript</u> and an <u>Account Transcript</u> at <u>www.IRS.gov</u>, or call 1-800-908-9946. If you have been the victim of identity theft, please contact our office for instructions.

**Please Read Instructions:** Complete this section if you (or your spouse, if married) <u>filed or will file</u> a 2020 income tax return With the IRS. The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of the FAFSA on the Web. If you have not already used the tool, go to <u>FAFSA.gov</u>, log into your FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2020 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA.

#### Check the box that applies:

I <u>have used</u> the IRS Data Retrieval Tool in FAFSA on the Web to retrieve and transfer my (and, if married, my spouse's) 2020 IRS income information into my FAFSA, either on the initial FAFSA or when making a correction to the FAFSA. Make sure to request the "<u>IRS tax Return Transcript</u>" You will need your social security number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2020 IRS tax return was filed).

Check here if your 2020 IRS tax return transcript or signed 2020 tax return is attached to this worksheet.

Check here if your 2020 IRS tax return transcript or **signed** 2020 tax return will be submitted to the school later. Verification cannot be completed until the 2020 IRS tax return or transcript has been submitted to the school.

## D. STUDENT NOT FILING TAX RETURN:

Complete this section if you will/did not file a 2020 income tax return with the IRS. You may also need to submit a letter of Non-filing from the IRS. You may request this letter by mail with the Form 4506-T. The form is available at <u>www.irs.gov</u> or in the Financial Aid Office.
