- 2. Vice President for College Advancement Update Dave Hutchison
  - a. GSC has received the ARC Power Grant for \$1.4M
  - b. This will fund running fiber and updating labs, and developing a crime simulator at the MTC, as well as other classroom updates
- 3. Nursing Program Update
  - a. The Nursing program is moving along well
  - b. Dr. Manchin would like to have a Department of Health Sciences in the future
