

Curriculum Committee Meeting

March 30, 2021

The minutes for the March 16, 2021 meeting were approved. (McKinney/Heaster)

Credit Hours for Internships and Work Experiences – There were no objections to indicating 135 clock hours per credit hour for the work experience courses (197 and 397) and 45 clock hours per credit hour for the internship courses (297 and 497). (Barr/Chapman)

Glennville State College Degree Inventory Language Consistent with WV HEPC Series 11 – Dr. Morris is requesting this information be included in the GSC catalog for clarification. The CIP-CODES do not change. Wildlife Management needs to be included. Health and Physical Education is dormant with the West Virginia State Department of Education. Please review and advise of any additional changes.

Program Review – Associate of Science in Forest Technology – Dr. Morris asked if members felt the program was ready to be submitted to the Board of Governors as it. There were no objections.

Department of Fine Arts – Dr. Barr presented catalog clean up of the Bachelor of Arts in Music based on the Appalachian Studies major. Appalachian Studies courses will not be included at this time in the BA Music. Theory III and Theory IV are back. Dr. Morris asked that a note be included stating the applied and theory courses are taken in sequence.

Minors: Dr. Morris is requesting students not be permitted to enroll in the following minors during the 2021-2022 academic year because these minors have had historically low enrollments and courses with low enrollments. Dr. Heaster requested Nonprofit Leadership remain for a couple of years based on student interest. Dr. Ensor agreed to not enroll students in Global Studies and History as the department considers revamping to reflect the recent changes in the History and Political Science major. Dr. Minton was not available to speak to Information and Media Studies. Physics will be removed.

Criminal Justice course outlines: Dr. Bryson indicated that the department plans to review all course outlines every 3 years. A memo outlining the changes was included. America was changed to “United States”. Course rotations will be not changing. The changes will not impact assessment, objectives will be more measureable. Bibliography has been removed from the outline template.

Education – Course outlines for EDUC 309 – General Music Methods and Materials and EDUC 349 – Teaching Music in Adolescent Education (9-Adult) were updated to include a 5-hour field experience. The credit hours for EDUC 309 was modified from 2 to 1.

New Courses (EDUC 470 and EDUC 480) – All teacher education programs will have year-long residencies effective Fall 2022. The programs were approved with this update but the courses were not included. The course outlines for EDUC 470 – Residency I and EDUC 480 – Residency II were provided.
