ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 2

NAMING OR RENAMING OF BUILDINGS

2.1. General.

- 1.1. Scope Policy regarding the naming or renaming of buildings.
- 1.2. Authority W. Va. Code §18B-1-6
- 1.3. Effective Date April 19, 2006
- 1.4. Repeal of Former Rule -Revises and replaces Title 131, Series 6 of the Board of Directors of the State University System. This policy supersedes any or all previous GSU policies in reference to naming or renaming of buildings.

2.2. Policy.

- 2.1. Approval by the Board of Governors is required for the naming or renaming of buildings at the institution.
- 2.2. The President of the institution is responsible for making the recommendation to the Board of Governors provided, however, that the president first inform the campus of his/her recommendation for the official name of a building, to be followed by a campus comment period of no less than one week prior to the President's recommendation to the Board of Governors.
- 2.3. A building may be named or renamed for an individual if that individual has rendered distinguished service to the institution or made a significant contribution. The individual may not have been employed at the institution during the three (3) previous years.
