Program Admission

Qualified high school students must be a junior or senior currently enrolled in the GSU Dual Credit/Enrollment Program with a high school overall cumulative GPA of 3.7 or higher.

Admission Process

- Complete the GSU High School Honors Program online application.
- 2. Write a 400 word essay on the topic provided via the GSU High School Honors Program online application.
- 3. Provide a list of extracurricular/ community activities that relate to leadership, service, and/or diversity.
- Submit a recommendation letter from a school official that speaks to the applicant's academic excellence, leadership, and community service.

Program Standards

- High School Honors Program students must have earned a 3.5 cumulative GPA in all dual credit/ enrollment courses at the end of each academic year.
- High School Honors Program students may receive a one-semester probation if their GPA declines below a 3.5.
- Failure to regain a 3.5 cumulative GPA at the end of the probationary period may result in removal from the Program.
