Writing Intensive (WI) & Critical Thinking (CT) Courses

- Pre-Nursing students need WI & CT course credit because of Marshall's program requirements
- Some faculty have already been through training with Marshall to teach WI & CT courses

- PSYC 201 is now being offered as CT for Pre-Nursing

- Dr. Amanda Chapman will also share this information with the General Education Taskforce
- WI courses are instructor-specific, CT courses are course-specific
- Courses may need to be approved by the Curriculum Committee depending on what needs edited/designated to align with objectives
