Advancement/Foundation and University Report - Dave Hutchison

- President Manchin is in Charleston today speaking at the Summit.
- Deferred maintenance the past legislative session \$209 million was given to HEPC to be divided out to all higher education institutions in the state.
 - \$5 million for Health Sciences that will help the Science Hall and Health & PE Building.
 - o Partial demolition of a few buildings (Louis Bennett Hall and Pickens Hall).
 - \$2.3 million to upgrade roads and pathways for ADA, parking lots, and walls.
 - o \$2 million for general campus repairs.
 - \$3.5 million for campus technology
 - \$1 million loan forgiveness
 - \$5.3 million for HVAC and energy projects
 - \$6.5 million for Athletics management
- Maureen and Kevin Evans will now be in the Health & PE Building to help structure Health Sciences. The state did award money for nursing.
- HEPC approved our MBA program; students may enroll beginning this fall.
- Admissions has been working hard to get recruits in.
