BILLING PROCESS CHANGE

Glenville State University no longer issues or mails paper bills. These changes were in response to increasing demands for a safe and convenient way to receive bills, as well as an effort to save paper and the environment at the same time.

Students are notified via their University-issued email that a new bill is available. Current account activity can be viewed at any time by logging into your EdNet account. Students are responsible for monitoring their account for changes that may occur from updates in course load, residence option, meal plan option, financial aid, or assessed late fees.

You, the student, are the primary contact with respect to your University billing and financial aid. You may allow your parent(s) or guardian(s) to speak to University representatives about billing and financial aid issues by adding your parent(s) or guardian(s) as authorized users.
