Academic Dishonesty Policy

- Liz and Mari worked together on revised draft wording
- Faculty are advised to report dishonesty, but can recommend the offense be a "teaching moment" or a punishment. Dishonesty cases should not only follow the policy, but also the faculty members' dishonesty policy in their syllabus
- If cases are not reported, student may get by with doing with this in every class and other instructors won't know
- Faculty are expected to abide by policy in the catalog, but also their policy in their syllabus as well
- Larry motioned to approve, Jeremy seconded. Kandas abstained. Motion passed.

Non-Degree Seeking Students

- Policy was revised to clarify information, and info regarding number of credits student can enroll in was removed

- Ann will add wording that states non-degree seeking students are students who are not enrolled in an Associate or Bachelor degree

- Larry motioned to approve with the changes, Bob seconded. Kandas voted against. Motion passed
