Biographical Note

Nelson L. Wells was born on February 20, 1911, in Glenville, West Virginia. He was the son of Noah and Clara Craddock Wells. Although he moved to Florida and graduated from Fort Pierce High School, Wells returned to Glenville and enrolled in class in 1930. Upon graduating from Glenville State Teachers College in 1934, Wells attended West Virginia University and received his master's degree. He also did post-graduate work toward his doctorate at North Western University and Peabody Institute of Nashville, Tennessee. Wells began his teaching career at Sand Fork High School and remained there until he began his service to Glenville State College as a supervising teacher in the summer training school of 1948

Wells made significant contributions to Glenville, the town, and the college. He taught courses in social studies, geography, and education. He helped establish a nine-week term for student teachers and was a student teacher advisor. Wells also helped start the Boy Scouts of America in Gilmer County and was a member of the Historical Society of Gilmer County.

He retired from Glenville State College in 1973 and was honored as a professor emeritus from Glenville State College. Wells was also a member of the Retired Teachers Association on local and state levels. In 1979, Professor Wells received the Alumni Service Award in recognition for his service to the Alumni Association and the college.

Even after his retirement, Wells still showed interest in the history of Glenville State College. Wells worked actively to preserve and collect historical records and artifacts of Glenville State College. Seven years before his death, Wells co-authored the book <u>Lighthouse on</u> <u>the Hill</u> with Charles Holt. This book recorded the history of Glenville State College from 1872-1997

Historical Note

Glenville State Teachers College was authorized to begin granting four-year Bachelor of Arts degrees in education in May of 1930. The name officially changed from Glenville State Normal School to Glenville State Teachers College to reflect its new status. Nelson Wells was one of the first people who graduated from this new four-year program. For the first time, Glenville was an official college.

By 1943, Glenville State Teachers College had attained national accreditation and the next 20 years brought about significant growth. The campus attained many new structures, including, Science Hall in 1943, the Health and Physical Education Building in 1952, and the Pioneer Center "aka Heflin Center", "aka Mollohan Campus Community Center in 1964.
