Biographical Note: John Arbuckle

John Arbuckle was a citizen of West Virginia who worked in the Kanawha Union Bank since 1901. He started at the bank as a bookkeeper and was later elevated to cashier in 1904. This collection is largely composed of newspaper articles and pictures, most relating to the bank, the people who worked with Arbuckle at the bank, and the happenings around Glenville. Also, this collection contains personal belongings and documents of people of the bank, including deposit books and mail.

Historical Note: United Bank was not always United Bank

United Bank first started out as Little Kanawha Valley Bank of Glenville. Later it became the First National Bank of Glenville and then was named Kanawha Union Bank. After it moved locations, the bank was eventually named United Bank. John Arbuckle was 95 years old and still working at the bank. This collection provides an idea of how much the bank meant to Arbuckle and others who worked alongside him.
