




Locating the housing application online

To get to the housing application, you will want to visit our website: Glenville.edu




Next, toggle your mouse over the "Student Life" portion of the banner.

Logging into the housing system




Log-in Information for First Time Freshmen

Username:

The 8 digits of your student ID number

Password:

Your password is the first letter of your first name capitalized, followed by your birthday in the format of DDMMYY, and then the first letter of your last name lower case. For example, if your name is John Smith and your birthday is December 31, 1989 your password would be J311289s.




Returning students will be able to log-in with their student ID number and email password

** Please note that if you change your email password, your log-in password to the housing application will change to your new password.



Select "Housing overview" to get to the application page.




** You will need to select whether or not you are a first time freshmen to continue!

Select the "Apply now" button to begin your application.




Now you are able to begin your application! Please fill out the following information on this page. All boxes must be filled to be submitted.

You will also get to select your primary sport.




Choose your preferred options from the list to the left. Move options up the list to indicate a higher preference.



After the Roommate Preference section, the housing application is close to being complete.


Meal plans will not be available to select until you receive your official housing assignment. Any student that does not select a meal plan option will be assigned the Blue All Access Meal Plan

Before submitting your application, you will receive a summary of your preferences and requests. You will also have a copy of the Housing Contract to review.


Submission of the application indicates that you agree to the terms and conditions of the Housing agreement.



Fill out the information below to let potential roommates know more about you.






Know who you want to room with? Create a roommate group!

Frequently Asked Questions & Additional Information

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will I receive my room assignment?

After completing the housing application, room assignments for the fall semester will be sent to you around the beginning/middle of July. You will also receive the name of your roommate.

How is my roommate selected?

Using the answers you provided on the questionnaire, Residence Life staff members do their best to pair students into housing arrangements. The staff attempts to match students with similar interests and habits. Keep in mind that you can request a specific roommate to live with you, but that person <u>must also request you on their application</u> as a roommate. Additionally, we suggest that you both try to submit your applications around the same time so neither is delayed in being processed, as <u>assignments are made automatically on a first apply, first assign basis</u>.

What if my new roommate and I don't get along?

Residence Life staff members encourage all students to give their roommate a 'test drive' for at least the first two weeks of school. If, after that time, you still wish to change rooms you may contact your Residence Hall Associate or a Resident Assistant for more information.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

After submitting your application, <u>any edits made will</u> <u>change the submission date and time.</u> If there is something you notice that needed changed, please contact Residence Life so your submission time is not affected.

You will not be able to search other students as roommates unless they have also filled out the housing application.

Singles and *Pioneer Village quickly fill up. We encourage students to fill out the housing application as soon as possible if these are desired room types as they are in high demand.
