- a. Facilities Committee: Representative Gibson gave everyone an update on several events that would be taking place at the school.
 - I. Money is available for spending, but people must be aware of where to put it.
 - II. Pickens Hall's floors are going to be renovated, but nothing will be done on the other side where people don't live.
 - III. The Friday before graduation will mark the grand opening of the renovated Clark Hall.
 - IV. Informed everyone that voluntary donations fix the football field, and that state funding is limited to the health and sciences.
 - V. Locks around campus are going to get fixed.
