NATURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT HIGH SCHOOL PATHWAY

A minimum of 24 credit hours, to be comprised of required natural resource management credits and general studies credits.

This required course:

ENVR 101 – Environmental Science (4 Credits)

At least one of the following two courses:

NRMT 125 – Computer Assisted Mapping (3 Credits)

NRMT 234 – GIS Application I (3 Credits)

At least one of the following two courses:

MATH 108 – Intro to College Math (3 Credits; prerequisite for MATH 115 for students who do not have math scores at or above 21 [ACT] or 530 [SAT])

MATH 115 – College Algebra (3 Credits)

The remaining credits should be selected from the following courses:

ENGL 203 – Survey of English Lit I (3 Credits)

ENGL 204 – Survey of English Lit II (3 Credits)

ENGL 205 – Survey of American Lit I (3 Credits)

ENGL 206 – Survey of American Lit II (3 Credits)

CART 101 – Intro to Public Speaking (3 Credits)

HIST 207 – United States History to 1877 (3 Credits)

HIST 208 – United States History since 1877 (3 Credits)

POSC 203 – American National Government (3 Credits)

PATHWAY ENROLLMENT

Requirements

- **High School junior or senior**
- **2.0 Cumulative GPA**
- **Be approved by your high school counselor or principle**
- **Complete the FEPR release form**

Students enrolled in the Natural Resource Management Pathway who attend participating high schools will receive all dual credit tuition and requited textbooks within the Natural Resource Management Pathway at no cost to them.
