

**COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
WEST VIRGINIA WESLEYAN COLLEGE AND GLENVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY
FOR:
MASTER OF ATHLETIC TRAINING**

This Agreement is entered into this 19th day of MAY, 2025, by and between West Virginia Wesleyan College ("WVWC") and Glenville State University ("GSU") (WVWC and GSU are sometimes collectively referred to hereinbelow as the "Parties").

Whereas, WVWC offers a professional Master of Athletic Training ("MAT") program; and

Whereas, it is the desire of the Parties for highly qualified students attending GSU to enter the WVWC's professional MAT program.

Now, therefore, the Parties agree as follows:

1. GSU will provide an undergraduate education that meets the stated requirements for WVWC's professional MAT program. GSU students must satisfy one of the following two pathways:
 - a. Complete an undergraduate bachelor's degree, in any major which includes the prerequisite courses required for admission into WVWC's professional MAT program, from GSU prior to matriculation into the WVWC's professional MAT program (4+2 model);
 - b. Complete a minimum of 91 credits towards an undergraduate bachelor's degree in Health Sciences with Pre-Athletic Training concentration from GSU prior to matriculation into WVWC's professional MAT program (3+2 model);
 - i. Students must complete all courses listed in Appendix I for the Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences with Pre-Athletic Training concentration;
 - ii. Students will earn their Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences with Pre-Athletic Training concentration from GSU upon successful completion of the 30 credits of WVWC Year1/Year 4 as outlined in Appendix II;
 - iii. Transcript showing successful completion of the 30 credits from WVWC must be requested by the student to be sent to GSU Registrar Office within 18 months after their last enrollment with GSU. GSU will waive the policy requiring students who interrupt their schooling for two or more regular academic semesters to be readmitted under the most current catalog.
2. WVWC's professional MAT program will accept up to four (4) GSU students each year, provided said students meet the following criteria:
 - a. Complete either undergraduate pathway at GSU as described above which meets the stated requirements for WVWC's professional MAT program;
 - b. Submit a Letter of Intent (Appendix III) to both WVWC and GSU Registrar's offices detailing the pathway for meeting the stated requirements for WVWC's professional MAT program with the expected entrance date
 - i. Early Assurance Pathway: Students may apply during their Freshmen or Sophomore year, guaranteeing a seat in WVWC's professional MAT program, and remain eligible by meeting all prerequisite courses from GSU and completing 50 observation hours with a certified athletic trainer;
 1. Students who complete the Health Sciences with Pre-Athletic concentration prior to matriculation to WVWC's professional MAT program (4+2 program) will satisfy the 50 observation hours with EXSC 493 Practicum;
 2. Students who enter WVWC's professional MAT program (3+2 program) after completion of a minimum of 91 credits towards Health Sciences with Pre-Athletic concentration must

complete 50 observations hours with a certified athletic trainer in addition to the required coursework

- c. Attain an overall cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale or higher;
 - d. Attain a grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale or higher in the required prerequisite courses, which includes, without limitation: BIOL 120, HLTH 105, HLTH 107, PED 201, HLTH 230, HLTH 231, PED 332, PED 421, CHEM 101, PHYS 201, PSYC 201, and MATH 256. Higher level courses may be substituted for lower-level courses in the same area;
 - e. Attain a minimum grade of C (2.0) in each required prerequisite course;
 - f. Complete online application with WVWC's Graduate Admissions Office including all requisite elements (undergraduate official transcript, essay, technical standards form, resume, two recommendations using the online graduate recommendation form, etc.);
 - i. WVWC shall waive deposits and offer a tuition discount rate of 5% for all eligible students from GSU;
 - ii. WVWC shall waive recommendation forms and offer a tuition discount rate of 10% for all GSU Early Assurance Pathway students;
 - g. Successfully complete the professional MAT program interview process;
 - i. WVWC shall waive interviews for all GSU Early Assurance Pathway students;
3. In addition, WVWC shall also require the following items for GSU students enrolling in its professional MAT program: physical examination within the last 12 months, copy of Hepatitis B immunization record or signed declination, current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) certification, Healthcare Provider or American Red Cross Professional Rescuer CPR and AED certification, criminal background check, drug screening, blood titers, universal precautions bloodborne pathogen training, National Athletic Trainers' Association student membership, and recommended direct observation experience with a certified athletic trainer.
4. All notices required under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given if: (i) delivered by hand and receipted for by the party to whom said notice or other communication shall have been directed; or (ii) mailed by certified or registered mail with postage prepaid, to the following addresses:

5. This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon six (6) months written notice to the other party. Provided that, WWC shall permit any student who has entered its program finish said program, including those students accepted into the Early Assurance pathway.
6. This Agreement may be immediately terminated if either party loses their accreditation status, ceases doing business, or for financial exigency of a party.
7. No provisions of this Agreement are intended, nor shall they be interpreted, to provide or create any third-party beneficiary rights or other rights of any kind.
8. This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the written consent of the other party.
9. This Agreement may be modified or amended upon mutual agreement of the Parties.
10. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of West Virginia.
11. The Parties to this Agreement are not partners or joint venturers with each other, and nothing herein shall be construed to constitute them as partners or joint venturers or impose any liability as such on either of them.
12. The provisions of this Agreement are intended to bind the Parties as to each other and are not intended to, and do not, create rights in any other person or confer upon any other person any benefits, rights or remedies, and no person is, or is intended to be, a third-party beneficiary of any of the provisions of this Agreement.
