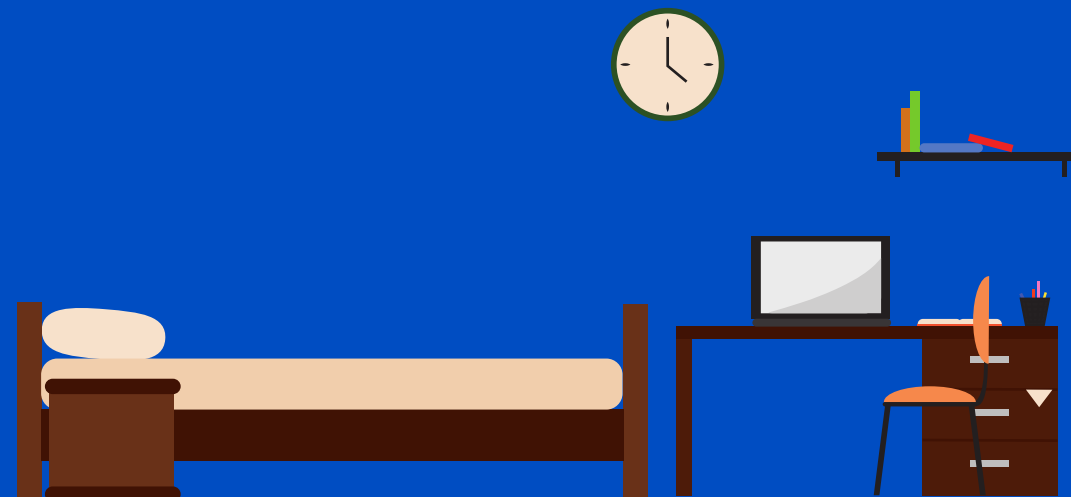




The 8 digits of your student ID number

Password:

Your password is the first letter of your first name capitalized, followed by your birthday in the format of DDMMYY, and then the first letter of your last name lower case. For example, if your name is **John Smith** and your birthday is **December 31, 1989** your password would be J311289s.

**** If your email was recently created (as of 4/28), you will use the 4 digit year rather than the two.**

EX: J31121989s



Returning students will be able to log-in with their student ID number and email password

**** Please note that if you change your email password, your log-in password to the housing application will change to your new password.**



Roommate Preferences ^

If you have a specific request for a roommate, you will have an opportunity to create a roommate pair or group after submitting your completed housing application. You can do so by selecting 'Roommate Groups' from the left side menu. Your chosen roommate will also need to have submitted a housing application for you to create a group with them.

If you're not sure who you'd like to live with yet, you can choose to search for possible roommates using Roomeez! Start by turning on your 'RoomeeZ' profile by selecting 'My Roommate Profile' from the left side menu. Here you can decide what information to share about yourself with potential roommates. Once you've turned on your profile, you'll be able to search for others and invite them to join a roommate group with you. Everyone you invite to your roommate group will need to accept the



LOTTERY AND ROOM SELECTION

Who can participate in the lottery & room selection?

Only upperclassmen are eligible to apply for Pioneer Village (PV) and participate in the lottery and room selection. To be entered into the lottery, you must list PV as your top choice. Additionally, you must answer yes for the question “Is Pioneer Village your top housing preference?”

How do I get my timeslot?

The lottery will be ran at a later date than when the housing application opens. Applicants will be given a timeslot with the time and date of when their application was submitted in mind. Students will receive email notification closer to the room selection date of what their timeslot is. We encourage all students to keep an eye on their GSU email.

When will room selection start?

Room selection will start at 10AM on Wednesday, May 20th, 2026. By this time, you will have received more information on how this process works as well as have gotten your timeslot.

****Disclaimer: Your confirmation number on your housing application receipt email is NOT your timeslot.**

PART 4:

Frequently Asked Questions & Additional Information

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will I receive my room assignment?

After completing the housing application, room assignments for the fall semester will be sent to you around the end of June/beginning of July. You will also receive the name of your roommate (if applicable).

How is my roommate selected?

Using the answers you provided on the questionnaire, Residence Life staff members do their best to pair students into housing arrangements. The staff attempts to match students with similar interests and habits. Keep in mind that you can request a specific roommate to live with you, but that person must also request you on their application as a roommate. Additionally, we suggest that you both try to submit your applications around the same time so neither is delayed in being processed, as assignments are made automatically on a first apply, first assign basis.

What if my new roommate and I don't get along?

Residence Life staff members encourage all students to give their roommate a 'test drive' for at least the first two weeks of school. If, after that time, you still wish to change rooms you may contact your Residence Hall Associate or a Resident Assistant for more information.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

After submitting your application, any edits made will change the submission date and time. If there is something you notice that needed changed, please contact Residence Life so your submission time is not affected.

You will not be able to search other students as roommates unless they have also filled out the housing application.

At this time, all spring applications will be processed with placements in Goodwin Hall. Please note that there are limited single rooms available, and are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
