Changes to Bylaws of the Promotion and Tenure Committee

Changes to Academic Policy's Graduation Requirement

- In order to be HLC compliant, transfer students must earn a minimum of 32 hours of the final 60 hours from GSC to graduate with a Bachelor's degree or 16 hours of the final 30 hours to earn an Associate's degree.
- Motion to approve by Baker / Vavrek (m/s). Motion passed unanimously.

Changes to Academic Policy's Probation and Suspension Policy

- Reduced hours from 42 to 30 hours whereby minimum GPA may be 1.5. Likewise, changed
 1.8 GPA as minimum during hours 31-60.
