Annual Fund Update

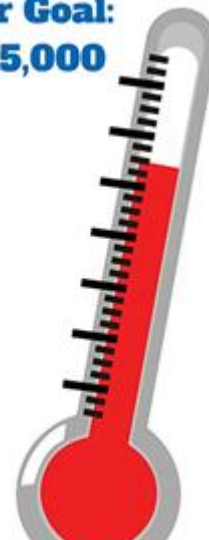
Donations to the Annual Fund are nearing \$18,000!
