Forever grateful that her life had been spared, Monica, who retired from Wood County Schools (WV) in July 2017 after spending 38 years teaching Learning Disabilities, 3rd and 4th grade, has become very active in heart awareness in her community.

She was "Heart Hero" at the American Heart Association's Heart Walk in Wood County this year and was also the leading individual fund raiser for this event.

Additionally, Monica has spent much of the past eight months working with Wood County Schools to get two AEDs (automatic external defibrillators) in each of the county's three high school football stadiums, one of these being placed at each stadium's concession stand and the other one's placement location being at each stadium's discretion.

For her persistence and desire to help other unsuspecting heart attack victims, we are proud to feature Monica in this weeks' Alumni Spotlight and proud that she is an alumna of Glenville State College.
